The Lake Eunice Township board held their monthly meeting at the town hall on April 3, 2007 at 7:05pm. All board members were present. The minutes from January were approved as written by a motion from M Reep, 2nd by J Renslow and it carried. Beth Schupp from Wildflower Golf Course was present for the signature of their liquor license. M Reep made a motion to approve the license, 2nd by J Renslow and it carried.

Mark Jacobson was present regarding N Pearl Lake Rd and the bad spot on the road. The plan is to dig that spot out and repair it this year. The county will loan us their traffic counters so that the decision for paving can be based on usage. Dust control will be reapplied this year.

Chris Heyer from Heyer Land Surveying was present with a final plat for "The Woods on Lake Maud" which is owned by Bradley and Cynthia Solheim. M Reep made a motion to approve the plat, 2nd by J Renslow and it carried.

The joint powers agreement with Audubon Twp on some of our roads was reviewed by the board. Some changes were made in the verbiage and it will be given to Shawn Felker to be redrafted for final signature.

A letter will be sent to the Cynthia Kennedy Trust to remove approach or install a culvert asap. M Reep researched the ability to create a website for the township. The cost of maintaining the (Lunar Pages) website would be \$6.95 per month. We will check into who we can hire to set this up for us.

Big Cormorant Lake Association is requesting a one year moratorium for development on the second and third tier as well as development in Cormorant Township at 7pm on April 10th at the Cormorant Townhall. We will have our supervisors attend this meeting for more information. Bill Sherlin was present questioning our zoning regulations and if the county will uphold our additional regulations if ones were set. More will be discussed at the May meeting once information is received at their meeting.

James Fletcher with Audubon Rescue was present to request a donation to purchase AED to replace the one that is now obsolete. He has received a grant to pay for half of the \$2200 machine. M Reep made a motion to donate \$583, 2nd by J Renslow and it carried.

A motion was made by M Reep to adjourn at 8:00 pm, 2nd by J Renslow and it carried.
