The Lake Eunice township board held the monthly meeting at the town hall on August 11, 2014 at 7pm. All members were present. The minutes from the July 8, 2014 meeting were approved by a motion from J Rosing, and 2nd by W Jacobson and it carried. Claims were reviewed for payment and transfer of adequate funds to cover payment of claims and payroll was approved as well as the treasurer's report which was reviewed and approved as written by a motion from E Clem, 2nd by J Rosing and it carried.

Jerome Engut was present at the meeting with a signed petition requesting Lake Eunice Township repair Dorff Beach road. A total of 16 signatures from Dorff Beach Rd. and 15 signatures from Morton Oaks Rd. were obtained. Discussion on this matter was decided to hire a professional road person that can look at all the roads in the township that need repair and prioritize which ones should be done first. The township has a lot of roads currently that are in need of repair. The township board told Jerome that by next late May to early June a priority list of the roads should be done and an update will be given at that time.

Dave Sherbrooke has a plat that was brought to the meeting that needed to be signed by the Chairman and Clerk. A motion was made to accept Eagle Crest Estates from J. Rosing, and 2nd by A. Bergquist and it carried. The township will take over this road when three family residential homes are occupied full-time and the road is rated at a Class B County Road.

Discussion was held about an access being put on Summer Haven Road for Cory Johnson to get his concrete pumper truck in and out of the property. A motion was made from W Jacobson, and 2nd by J Rosing and it carried allowing Cory Johnson access on Summer Haven Road within the first 150 feet of the center line of county road 11, this will restrict him to his concrete pumper truck for the heavy piece of equipment.

Discussion on setting times to go and look at the Vandal property that is ready to proceed to vacating the hammerhead portion time is set for 5:30 PM September 9th. The Upton property will be viewed by the supervisors at 6:00 PM September 9th.

The township has received a bill from Driveway Services for putting down class 5 materials on Bass Lake Estates. The clerk will be sending out a bill to Tom Bergren, Lake Park for reimbursement for this. A motion was made from E Clem, and 2nd by W Jacobson and it carried.

Don Dodd was present asking for more compensation on the bituminous patching that he did. We had paid him \$35,000 due to the quotes that we had received and he is not satisfied with that amount and his lawyer will take further action if not settled tonight. The board had discussion to pay an additional \$6,000 payment to Don Dodd to settle the road patching project and to be handled through our township attorney. A motion was made by J Rosing, and 2nd by E Clem and it carried.

A motion to adjourn at 9:18pm by A Bergquist, 2nd by W Jacobson.
