The Lake Eunice Township board held their monthly meeting at the town hall on December 9, 2008 at 7:05pm. All members were present with Cynthia Danielson filling in as the deputy clerk. The minutes from November were approved as written by a motion from L Kohler, 2nd by J Renslow, and it carried. The treasurer's report was approved as written by a motion from L Kohler, 2nd by J Renslow and it carried.

Warren, Sharon, and Betty Wilson present regarding Warren's property on Big Corm Rd and an issue they had with a portion of Old Cty 6 being vacated giving them no easement to their lot. M Reep suggested they retain an attorney to review abstract and advise them on how to proceed.

Rick Renner stated that Todd Halderson doesn't want the bus to go past his house anymore and offered to pay for the materials necessary to put in a turn around. L Kohler suggested Todd attend a meeting to discuss this. Keith Zachariason (LPA bus manager) asked if the twp could call Mark Halderson (Todd's son). L Kohler will do this.

Rick Renner questioned who the primary snowplow driver and it was determined that he would be the primary and be responsible for filling it with fuel and sand. L Kohler will be the backup driver.

Steven Evans requested that they wing out the snow as far as possible. He also has a 10" drop to a culvert due to re-engineering of neighbor's property. He will be landscaping this spring and wants the twp to consider paying for the sod. This will be reviewed in March or April.

Bill Rutherford would like Peterson Circle reg raveled due to the snowplow pushing it off the road. Also, N Pearl is full of washboards and the township will look at the problem and correct it.

Letters will be sent to 3 township residents that have items in the right-of-way per the request of M Reep.

There was a discussion of the survey of Maple Lodge Rd. A big oak tree needs to be removed on Tanglewood Dr which will be done by Rick Renner in the spring.

The assessment of twp signs showed that 43 were bad and we will concentrate on replacing the control signs first. L Kohler suggested ordering our signs ourselves instead of going through the county. There are also several signs blocked by trees and this will be taken care of in the spring by Rick Renner.

Reep received quotes from CS1 on paving Deroxe, N Pearl, Peterson Circle and Lane and Little Pearl Rd. The repairs on these roads need to be accounted for in the budget and more accurate quotes will be gained at a later date.

L Kohler stated there is a foundation started in the turnaround on Buckhorn Rd and it is too close to the road but has been approved by zoning. He also found a culvert on Leaf Lk Rd that needs attention and is having Brad Wentz check on it.

A motion was made to adjourn at 8:38pm by J Renslow, 2nd by L Kohler and it carried.
