The Lake Eunice Township Board held their monthly meeting at the town hall on February 8, 2011. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00pm.

Present: Lloyd Kohler, Joe Lightowler, Gerald Johnson, Cindy Danielson (Deputy Clerk)

Absent: Crystal Myers, Ruth Pung, David Opsahl and Larry Stockert

New Business:

- 2 Liquor License Renewals by Wildflower and Pit 6-11
- Mike Reep was present representing the Midnight Riders Snowmobile Club. He asked if there were any concerns with the weekend ride. Lloyd Kohler reported that there were over 20 violations of snowmobilers riding across his alfalfa field. The DNR issued citations and fines. Some discussion of groomer issues on the snowmobile trails and the piles of snow left on private driveways.
- Mark Jacobson commented about the January meeting and the fact that the discussion about the budget should have included the fact that the board discussed that there would be an attempt to not have to raise taxes in 2011. The minutes were amended.
- Minutes were amended to read, "No increase in taxes for 2011 will be considered at the Annual Meeting Budget" Minutes were accepted as amended. Motion by Kohler and 2nd by Johnson. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report and meeting minutes was presented by Lightowler. Motion to accept the Report by Kohler. 2nd by Lightowler. Motion Carried.

- Mark Jacobson- on behalf of Bill Rutherford, he presented a petition to place Otta Seal on Peterson Circle and Peterson Lane. There will be no cost assessed to the Township. The petition will be sent to the Attorney for approval and the Twp Clerk will verify signatures. He also appreciated the Treasurer's Report being posted on the website. Mike Reep agreed with the comment stating that it is beneficial to the residents.
- Mark had a question about the sate for the Absentee Ballot Judge Training. Crystal will notify the judges and arrange a training time.
- Johnson made a motion to change the date of the March regular meeting from March 8th to March 15th for the purpose of paying the March bills and conducting the reorganization meeting that follows the Annual Meeting. Kohler 2nd. Motion carried. Notices of this change will be posted.
- Discussion of Oien Lane- the resident on the road wants it plowed by the Township, however there is no turn-around. There has been contact with the County about this matter by the town board. Reep also commented that if improvements need to be made that cost should be assessed to the property owner. The plow cannot drive on private property to turn around. Rick Renner was involved in discussion of options. It was agreed to wait until the snow melts to make a decision.
- Kohler- received a call about a mailbox that had been knocked over by the snow plow. It was not a swing-away post. Kohler fixed it, but the board reminded him that mailboxes must be on a swing-away post on roads posted at over 45 MPH, and that the Township is not responsible to fix damage.

Kohler motioned to adjourn at 7:42 pm. Johnson 2nd. Motion carried
