The Lake Eunice Township board held their bi-monthly meeting at the town hall on July 13, 2010 at 7pm. All members were present. The minutes from June 22nd were approved as written by a motion from L Kohler, 2nd by L Stockert and it carried. The treasurer's report was read and approved by a motion from L Stockert, 2nd by G Johnson and it carried.

J Renslow officially resigned as township supervisor as he is moving out of the area.

There is a new method to crackfilling and patching roads and there will be a meeting at Swanson to be announced.

J Lightowler received a call from Guy Fischer at the County and has asked the township to approve a resolution for allowing a tax exemption for the JOBZ program at R&B Labs that will create at least 5 new jobs. L Stockert made a motion to approve this exemption, 2nd by G Johnson and it carried.

Becker County Soil and Water are holding a meeting at 1pm on July 14, 2010 at the townhall prior to their invasive weed tour.

Chuck Lenthe of Anderson Passe & Associates was present to discuss the federal requirements for sign reflectivity and offered the services of his firm to do a report based on an inspection of the township signs to help with this. The contract entails the township deciding on one of 4 different options on how to replace signs needing to be updated and the fee is \$2500 for locating and inspecting signs and making a report on what is needed. The report can then be accepted by the township as the required reflectivity replacement plan. He observed a few roads and noticed that he could most likely recommend 25% of the signs be removed as they are unnecessary. G Johnson agrees that a blanket replacement of signs for reflectivity needs to be done. G Johnson made a motion to hire this company to perform this service with the option of a blanket sign replacement, 2nd by L Stockert and it carried.

The public hearing for the vacation of W Lk Eunice portion of the dedicated road for Kragnes was held at 7:30pm and then the regular meeting resumed.

Tarnowski Rd, 134th St and W St Peters Rd will be looked at to make a decision on these roads continuing as minimum maintenance roads only. The supervisors will go look at these roads at 7pm on Monday, Aug 2nd.

The dust control has been completed on various township roads.

Erickson Rd, soft spot on Deroxe Rd and Jay Carlson compost pile have all been completed.

The following quotes were received for the N Pearl Lk Rd repair:

- Olson Construction - \$4290
- Keith Drewes Construction - \$3350
- Driveway Services - \$3100

L Stockert made a motion to have Driveway Services complete this project, 2nd by L Kohler and it carried.

L Stockert made a suggestion to have all residents that are interested in filling Jim's vacancy to come to the August 3rd meeting so that the board members can meet them before making motions on appointing a replacement.

Larry also noticed that brushing needs to be done on our ditches. Dave Opsahl made a suggestion that it would be a fraction of a cost to mow and then spray every other year to keep the weeds down. L Stockert will begin making a list of roads that need work done on ditches.

G Johnson would like to get road closed signs that costs approx \$150 per sign for use when our road projects are being worked on. G Johnson made a motion to purchase 2 signs to be used by contractors, 2nd by L Stockert and it carried.

A motion was made to adjourn at 8:21 pm by L Kohler, 2nd by G Johnson and it carried.
