The Lake Eunice Township board held their monthly meeting at the town hall on June 6, 2006 at 7:00pm. All board members were present. The minutes from May were accepted as written by a motion from M Reep, 2nd by J Renslow and it carried. The treasurer's report was accepted by a motion from J Renslow, 2nd by M Reep and it carried.

Bill Rutherford and Harry Napier were present to discuss Peterson Circle. We are waiting for a bid on the road.

George Hettenbaugh was concerned about the water level on Eilertson Lake Road. He stated that the bank is eroding and will eventually cause damage to the road.

Shelly Townsend and Bill Sherlin were present regarding the Lake Maud development with concerns of critical habitat and the lots being smaller than the standards of 2 ½ acres that is required. The board will attend the meeting of the County board and a letter will be sent by J Carlson.

Mark Jacobson of N Pearl Lake Rd stated concerns that the gravel was not spread consistently and that soft spots were not repaired first as well as the gravel not being good quality and that not enough was spread. The gravel will be bladed to spread consistently on the normal blading day as planned and the board is keeping an eye on the soft spots.

Dave Howard was present to have his 3.2 beer license signed for the Deroxe Club. A motion was made by M Reep to sign the license as soon as he obtained the correct paperwork being he is a few months past the renewal date, 2nd by J Renslow and it carried.

Jim with the Audubon Fire Dept applied for a grant to install dry hydrants and it was received. This will pay for ½ the cost and they are requesting the remaining funds from the township. M Reep made a motion to allot the funds to the fire dept, 2nd by J Renslow and it carried.

Shawn Felker present from Audubon Twp regarding the 2 ½ acre requirement for 2nd tier lots not being recognized by the county. J Carlson will send a letter stating our requirements and both townships feel we may have to start doing our own zoning enforcement. Sugar Island Rd needs to be rebuilt and we'd like to do this with a joint powers agreement. This will be discussed.

The township computer will be replaced with a newer version.

A motion was made by M Reep to adjourn at 9:00pm, 2nd by J Renslow and it carried.
