The Lake Eunice Township board held their monthly meeting at the town hall on October 13, 2009 at 7pm. All members were present. The minutes from September were approved as written by a motion from J Lightowler, 2nd by J Renslow, and it carried. The treasurer's report was approved as written by a motion from L Stockert, 2nd by J Lightowler and it carried.

Chad Lofgren was present from Bass Lake Estate requesting what is needed to have his driveway plowed. It is a requirement for there to be 3 residences in this development before it can be considered to be maintained.

Rick Renner was present to discuss the plans for snowplowing and any roads that he has turnaround issues. J Lightowler discussed roads that need to be repaired including S Big Corm Lk Rd that has a pothole that needs immediate attention. L Stockert stated that E Pearl needs gravel and there were a few places that need letters to remove items from the right-of-way. L Kohler stated that Meadow Lane is ready to be maintained. L Stockert made a motion to take over the maintenance, 2nd by L Kohler and it carried. The Toybox road needs stop signs, more gravel and reduce the road width to 28' before maintenance can be considered. L Kohler made a motion to continue plow in the Sportsmen Club lot, 2nd by L Stockert and it carried. J Renslow discuss the current variance requests and M Reep is going to talk to zoning as to more specific rules for putting up a steel shed.

The Lions are requesting to put in a permanent container by our recycling shed at the townhall and the Lake Eunice Store to collect their cans and they will keep it maintained. The board members requested that they enclose it so that it is not visible and not attracting animals or bees. J Renslow will pass this along and see if they agree.

The tree on Tanglewood Rd was cut down due to it being located so close to the road (in the right-of-way) and being a road liability.

A motion was made to adjourn at 8:50 pm by L Kohler, 2nd by L Stockert and it carried.
