The Lake Eunice Township Board held their monthly meeting at the town hall on September 8, 2009 at 7 pm. All members except for Crystal Myers were present. The minutes of August 25th were approved as written by a motion from Lloyd Kohler and 2nd by Joe Lightowler, and it carried. The treasurer's report was approved as written by a motion from James Renslow and 2nd by Joe Lightowler and it carried.

Ken Christianson needed an acknowledgement from the Township Board for the plat on the Woods on Lake Maud. Jim motioned to approve the plat and Larry 2nd it. Ken will contact Crystal and Mike to sign the approval.

Dan Lubbersmeyer from West Lake Eunice asked for a variance as he is remodeling and putting a garage and a septic system in. Mike indicated to Dan that a form will need to be signed and Crystal has this particular form on her computer. Mike will get the form and necessary signatures to Dan so Grant Ohm can start work on this project. Motion made by Joe and 2nd by Lloyd to approve this.

Jane Townsend was at the meeting to discuss the minimum maintenance road by County 22 and Nelson Market Road. They had posted private property and no dumping signs at various times and had a break in back in 2002 and lost quite a bit of personal property at that time. She brought pictures of various things that have happened on this property and have been in touch with the sheriff's department regarding their situation. They just wanted to bring it to the board's attention as to what is happening there and would like this road to be vacated, before something dangerous happens, as they consider it to be a liability. It seems that once Hogue shuts down on the weekends, it turns into a party place and they would like this to stop. Mike explained to them what they would need to do to have this road vacated.

Dana Hendricks gave an update on the roads. Lloyd felt we had enough moisture that Scott could go back out to blade very lightly.

The Board went through all of the Becker County variances.

Lloyd talked to Dean at the Landfill and he talked to Skoag from the Assessors Dept. to have a couple of loads of crushed concrete hauled into the compost site.

Per Mike, we should be getting the first check from the Homeland Security which is the reimbursement for the emergency work that was done on the roads that were flooded.

A discussion was had about the bill from Rick Renner on the work that was done on the Deroxe road. Both Mike and Larry were there when Rick was working and agreed that there had to be more work done than what the bid was for.

A motion was made to adjourn at 8:31 pm by Lloyd, 2nd by Larry and it carried.
